

But when was the last time you changed your acrylics??

Over time, acrylic material DECOMPOSES and BLOCKS UV rays. This results in less color developemnt for the tanner and more dissatisfied customers for you, the salon owner!

The average lifespan of a quality acrylic is between 1500 and 3000 hours. This will vary based on unique salon conditions and maintenance programs.

To MAXIMIZE the efficiency and longevity of your acrylics follow this simple maintenance schedule:

DAILY- Clean acrylics after every session with approved disinfectant. Check for cracks.

WEEKLY- Clean & polish bench and canopy acrylics. Remove and clean acrylic tracks when applicable. Wipe and remove dust from around lamps and fans.

Monthly- Inspect for cracks, scratches, and yellowing. Check UV transmission of acrylics with a UV meter, replace if necessary.
