

RE: Alaska Sales & Use Tax Exemption

Dear Customer:

According to Alaska Remote Seller Sales Tax Commission Uniform Code, we must have either

1) A Reseller Sales Tax Exemption Certification from Alaska Remote Seller Sales Tax Commission

OR

2) A copy of your Alaska Business License AND a copy of your Local Jurisdictions Sales Tax/Seller's Permit

OR

3) A copy of your Local Jurisdictions Exemption Certificate

on file in order to grant tax-exempt status to you as a customer.
